Program Summary

This 3-day summer program will introduce your children to the fresh water, coastal and island environments of Discovery Bay & Peng Chau, searching for the wild and wonderful creatures that live there. They will learn about the importance of these local ecosystems creating an awareness and understanding of our natural wonders and helping to inspire them all to become better guardians of our natural world.

Day 1 - Beach & Coastal Discovery

- Nature art challenge and 'Hey trash get off my beach' activity

Afternoon (indoor classroom)

- Magic of Coral Reef presentation with coral reef bingo & sculptionary



Day 2 - Peng Chau Exploration

- Visit the remote beaches & hike the Family Trail
- Explore the intertidal zone of a rocky coastline
- Visit the ancient temples of Peng Chau Island & discover its' pirate legends



Day 3 - Mini Gorge Hike & Environmental Challenge

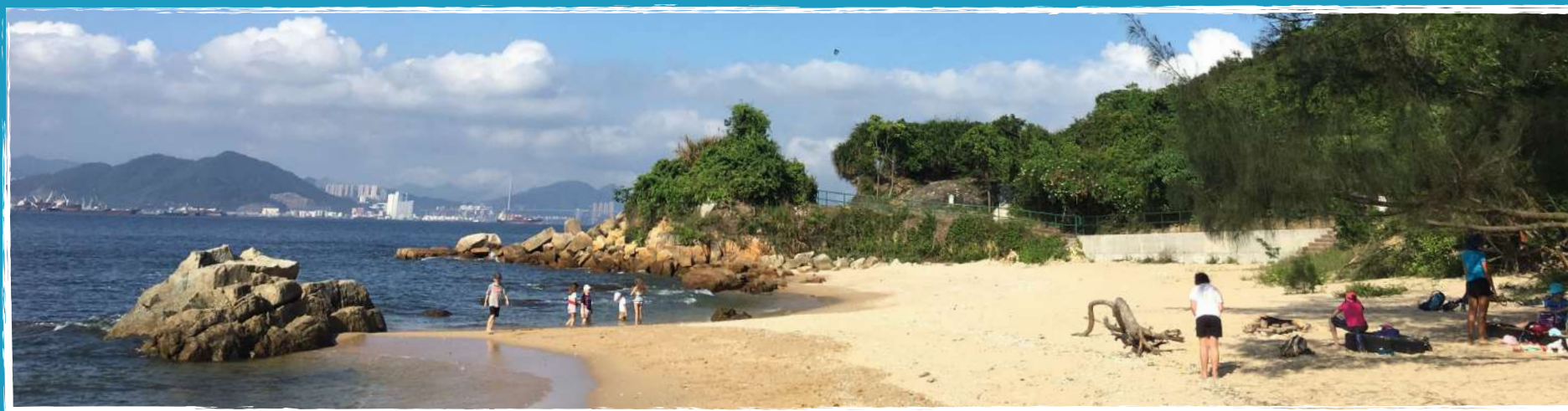
Discovery Bay, Lantau
